Jonah 1	<p>Who: Jonah, son of Amittai, The LORD, Sailors, Captain</p> <p>What: [The LORD] tells Jonah to go preach against Nineveh because of its wickedness</p> <p>[Jonah] heading in the opposite direction; running from God; fleeing from the Lord; [The LORD] sends a Storm and a great fish</p> <p>Where: Sailing from Joppa toward Tarshish; On a ship, in the sea, inside a big fish</p> <p>When: [Written Before 722 BC at least] Chronology of account: Before being swallowed by a great fish</p> <p>Why: - Preach against Nineveh b/c of wickedness</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - He sailed for Tarshish to flee from the Lord (v. 3) - He knew the storm came because of Him - Sailors fear the Lord because the sea is calmed <p>How: - Jonah fled by boat;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sailors tried to deal with storm by: crying to their own gods, lightening the ship, casting lots to see who was to blame. - The sea was calmed when they threw Jonah into it. - The fish was provided by the LORD 	<p>Type of Literature: Mostly Narrative with some Poetry</p> <p>Don't know exactly when written</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Don't know exactly why he is fleeing yet. (Ch. 4) - Don't know why the Lord chose to use a great fish. - Don't know exactly what kind of fish God provided. - Don't know how exactly he stayed alive.
