<p><b>Ch. 3</b></p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p><b>Keywords:</b>                      *Word of the Lord                      *Sackcloth                      *Relent                      *Compassion</p> </div>	<p><b>Who:</b> God/Jonah/Ninevites/King  <b>What:</b> - The word of the LORD to Jonah a 2<sup>nd</sup> time.                      - <i>Jonah</i> obeyed &amp; announced coming judgment.                      - <i>Ninevites</i> believed God/fasted                      - The <i>King</i> hears &amp; calls people to repent/call on God.                      - <i>God</i> sees what they do and relents from destruction.  <b>Where:</b> Nineveh (all over the city)  <b>When:</b> (c. 782 -753 BC) Reign of Jeroboam II [After the whale!]  <b>Why:</b> Jonah obeys the word of the LORD after having tried to flee and being swallowed by a whale.  <b>How:</b> <i>Jonah</i> – Publicly proclaims impending judgment for sin.  <i>Ninevites</i> – Respond by believing, fasting, mourning, repenting and calling on God.  <i>God</i> – Responds to their faith/belief/repentance by relenting of judgment.</p>		
<p><b>Ch. 4</b></p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p><b>Keywords:</b>                      *Angry/                      Anger                      *Right                      *Compassionate                      *Gracious                      *Die                      *Concern</p> </div>	<p><b>Who:</b> Jonah/The LORD  <b>What:</b> - <i>Jonah</i> is angry &amp; wants to die.                      - <i>God</i> responds and provides a plant (comfort)                      - <i>Jonah</i> is happy about the plant.                      - <i>God</i> sends a worm &amp; a hot wind (discomfort)                      - <i>Jonah</i> is angry again.                      - <i>God</i> queries Jonah about his anger and asks him a rhetorical question.  <b>Where:</b> A place east of the city of Nineveh  <b>When:</b> (c. 782 -753 BC) Reign of Jeroboam II [After Nineveh repents]  <b>Why:</b> - <i>Jonah</i> is angry because he knows how God will respond to the Ninevites repentance.                      - <i>Jonah</i> is happy about the plant.                      - <i>Jonah</i> is angry when the plant dies.  <b>How:</b> <i>God</i> interacts with <i>Jonah</i> verbally &amp; by circumstances.</p>
